Proposals will be evaluated based on the responses to the following questions:

1. Name of Firm, Contact Person, Address, Telephone Number, E-mail Address
2. Historical background of the firm.
3. Identify the lead architects, engineers, and/or planners who will be working on the project and give specific educational project experience.
4. List and explain any consultants that may be used by your firm for this project.
5. Describe your firm's experience and background with helping school districts with their master plans.
6. Describe your firm's experience and background with K-12 school projects, particularly high schools.
7. Describe the team's experience with educational planning initiatives, including experience with 21st Century learning principles.
8. Describe your firm's experience with comprehensive renovation projects.

9. List a maximum of four (4) specific and unique qualities, which sets your firm apart from others, as it relates to our specific project.

All proposals submitted by the date due will be evaluated and ranked in an objective manner. This ranking of completed RFQ's will determine the need for interviews if deemed necessary by the district.
